Carrier goes year-round with Williams Gateway flight schedule

SkyValue USA said Friday it would expand its winter schedule of flights from Gary, Ind., to Mesa/Phoenix, Las Vegas and the Florida cities of Orlando and St. Petersburg/Tampa to year-round service.

Based in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., SkyValue on Dec. 15, 2006, announced a flight schedule that was originally slated to end April 22.

According to its latest schedule, which begins Saturday, SkyValue will offer flights between Gary Chicago International Airport and Williams Gateway Airport in Mesa. The flights, using Boeing 737-800 aircraft, will be offered on Mondays and Fridays. The plane will arrive at Williams Gateway from Gary at 9:24 a.m., and begin the return flight a little over an hour later at 10:30.

Gary Chicago Airport is located 35 miles from downtown Chicago, according to a statement from SkyValue. According to the SkyValue Web site, the base fare for a one-way ticket is \$79 and for a round-trip ticket is \$158.

SkyValue will offer flights between Gary and Las Vegas on Thursdays and Sundays; flights between Gary and Orlando on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays; and between Gary and St. Petersburg on Thursdays and Saturdays.

The flights will be operated by Xtra Airways, a charter carrier based in Elko, Nev.
