

Mesa airport officially gets name changed

On Oct. 15, Williams Gateway Airport will become Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport. A crowd of 75 to 80 people packed the meeting room to hear the Williams Gateway Authority, the governing board of the east Mesa airport, unanimously OK the change.

But despite pre-meeting rumblings, nobody spoke in opposition to the new name.

As part of the resolution, the passenger terminal will be dubbed the Charles L. Williams Passenger Terminal, and the park, which is already named after the World War I pilot from southern Arizona, will be expanded.
