Westcor announces tenants at Casa Grande mall

Westcor, a Valley-based mall developer and operator, unveiled a handful of retailers that will anchor a new shopping mall in Casa Grande.

Called The Promenade, the project sits on 130 acres at the northeast corner of Interstate 10 and Florence Boulevard in Casa Grande and will include more than 1 million square feet of retail, dining and entertainment.

Best Buy, a Harkins Theatres 14-screen movie complex, JC Penney, Kohl's, Staples and Target were announced Tuesday as tenants of the new project.

"The Promenade at Casa Grande's enticing mix of department stores, free-standing retail shops, restaurants and a multiplex theater in an urban village setting will take the region's retail options to a new level," said Casa Grande Mayor Charles T. Walton in a statement.

The project is expected to serve residents in the East Valley and Northern Pinal County including towns such as Eloy, Coolidge, Florence and Sacaton.

Developed through Westcor, WDP Partners and The Pederson Group, the first phase of the project is expected to open this fall.
